

# NS&I Residual Account repayment application

Where an NS&I account or holding has been closed by us and we have been unsuccessful in contacting a customer to return the money invested, the money is transferred to an NS&I Residual Account until the customer contacts us.

**If you have an account or holding with NS&I that has now transferred to the Residual Account – for example Easy Access Savings Account, Ordinary Account, Deposit Bonds, Save As You Earn, Yearly Plan, Gift Tokens, Savings Stamps or British Savings Bonds – you can use this form to withdraw your money.**

Please note that you can only withdraw the whole amount in an NS&I Residual Account; you cannot withdraw part of the money and leave the remainder invested.

Please write in **BLACK CAPITAL LETTERS** inside the boxes. This helps us process your form faster.
